Native Plant Sourcing & Nurseries

Plant Selection & Sourcing

Collecting plants in the wild can devastate plant populations. Ethical native plant producers propagate their plants at the nursery by plant division, from cuttings or seed. When purchasing native plants, be sure to confirm the source.

Because plants vary from region to region, it is best to use stock from your local area or the next closest geographic region.

If you are shopping at a nursery that doesn't specialize in native plants, always check the scientific or Latin name. Common names can inaccurately classify plants.
