Project Type:

- Concept Design
- Preliminary Engineering
- Construction - Bus Stop Improvements

Project Locations:

- Grand River at Halsted (eastbound bus stop)
- Grand River at Drake (eastbound bus stop)
- Grand River at Liberty (eastbound bus stop)
- Grand River at 9 Mile (westbound bus stop)

Project Description:

Install new ADA compliant bus shelters with seating, install key walks between the sidewalk to level boarding areas, fill in sidewalk gaps, trash receptacles, benches at four stops with service along SMART Bus Routes 305 and 805.

Project Funding:

- Access to Transit Grant: \$80,000
- Local Match: \$20,000
- Total Project Budget: \$100,000

Anticipated Completion Date:

July/August 2026



Project Update:

- All the existing bus stops in the City have been evaluated
- The City of Farmington gathered bus stop shelter specifications, determined amenities needed at each location and prepared the project cost estimate
- Completed preliminary engineering/design and prepared final construction plans
- Bus stop shelters are being fabricated
